Acts 4:13-22 Community Group Questions

- 1. Spend some time reviewing this week's passage and message. Was there anything that stood out to you, encouraged or challenged you?
- 2. Peter and John are examples of boldness and courage here, but that wasn't always the case (see Matthew 26:69-73). How do you think we can grow in courage as Christians?
- 3. Read 1 Corinthians 1:26-29. Why is it helpful for us to remember our calling? In what ways are we tempted to distance ourselves from our humble state and instead seek influence by our level of education or social standing?
- 4. Who are some of the people who have made the biggest impact in your life?
- 5. Read the following passages: Romans 12:17-21; Colossians 4:6; Titus 2:7-8; 1 Peter 2:15; 3:15. What do these verses suggest about our posture towards those who might oppose our message?
- 6. The response of those who learned of Peter and John's release from prison was to pray. Read the next section of Acts 4 (verses 23-31). Spend some time praying for our witness in these present days.
