Acts 5:12-42 Community Group Questions

- 1. What are some of the things happening in our world or culture at large that tempt you to think that we are fighting a losing battle? What are some of the things that cause you to have a sense of optimism about the church?
- 2. Read the following verses: Acts 2:41,47; 4:4; 5:14. How would you describe the growth of the early church? Beyond numerical growth, what are some other indicators that the church was growing in a healthy direction? (see Acts 4:32; 5:11,16)
- 3. The response to the Apostle's preaching can be seen on a continuum in this passage. There seem to be 4 distinct responses:
 - a. Outright opposition (vv.17-18,33)
 - b. A wait and see approach (vv.34-39)
 - c. Hesitancy and respect (v.13)
 - d. Joyful acceptance (v.14)

Why do you think it is important to keep this in mind when trying to share the gospel with others?

- 4. What does faithfulness look like in the face of opposition? Do you think we tend to focus too much on results and not enough on obedience?
- 5. How does focusing on Jesus' promises about the church (Matthew 16:18) and God's sovereignty (think Gamaliel) boost your confidence with regard to the present and future state of the church?
- 6. Spend some time praying specifically for the church at large and for the ministry of Crossridge.
