

## Community Group Questions – *Genesis 39:1–23*

1. Read Genesis 39. What did you find most helpful, encouraging, or challenging from this week's passage and message?
2. The refrain of Genesis 39 is "The LORD was with Joseph." How does the reality of *God with us* encourage you in your current season of life?
3. Joseph's success in Potiphar's house was credited to the Lord, not just his hard work. How do you typically view your own "successes" — as your own doing, or as God's providence?
4. Joseph remained faithful when tempted by Potiphar's wife, but instead of reward he was falsely accused and thrown in prison. How do you respond when obedience to God seems to cost you rather than bless you? What passages or promises would you turn to during such seasons?
5. Can you share a time when you experienced God's presence most clearly during a season of hardship in your life?
6. Joseph's story reflects the pattern of exaltation → humiliation → exaltation, which also points forward to Jesus. How does seeing Joseph's story through that lens deepen your understanding of the gospel?
