

## Worship Tech Team (Audio/Visual)

**Mission Statement:** St. Mark worship ministry exists to provide all music and presentation aspects of each worship service.

**Description:** Worship technicians serve the congregation by facilitating the worship service through selected songs and resources.

**Qualifications:** Proficiency and/or willingness to train in one or more of the following areas:

- Soundboard technician
- ProPresenter worship display operator
- Lighting technician

**Responsibilities:** Utilize Planning Center (online and mobile app) to manage schedules and access resources. Listen to songs at home and be prepared for rehearsal/services. Help facilitate the worship service on a given weekend or service at either campus.

**Time Commitment:** Worship tech team members are usually asked to commit to once a month (more if deemed necessary).

**De Pere:**

- Soundboard: 15-30 minutes listening to songs, 1 hour rehearsal, 3 weekend services (1 hour each)
- ProPresenter/Lighting: 15-30 minutes listening to songs, 1 weekend service (1 hour)

**Green Bay:**

- Soundboard and ProPresenter Techs: 15-30 minutes listening to songs, 30 minute rehearsal, 1 Sunday service (1 hour)

**Relationships:** Worship tech team members operate mostly “behind-the-scenes” in the control booth. Worship team members serve under Worship Director Tim Babler and Worship Coordinator Shelly Johnson.

**Training:** In-person and video resource training is available for all worship music team members. Worship tech team members will be given multiple in-person training sessions before going solo.
