Description:

Qualifications:

Responsibilities:

- Serve at scheduled services:
 - Make sure the online platform is ready to receive the video feed
 - Switch between the camera and the presentation feed while recording/streaming
 - Monitor audio levels

Time Commitment:

- 1 hour during the Saturday 5:00pm service
- Typically one service a month, potentially 2 depending on if there is a 5th weekend in the month and other staffing availability
