## **Advent Candle Lighting**

Reader 1: In the days of the prophet Haggai, God's people stood before a temple that seemed too small and too fragile to hold their hopes. But God spoke a promise: "My Spirit remains among you; do not fear... The latter glory of this house shall be greater than the former... and in this place I will give peace."

Reader 2: God's peace is not the work of our hands—it is the gift of God's presence, still with us, still restoring, still reconciling.

Congregation: We long for God's peace. We prepare our lives for the Prince of Peace. We turn our hearts toward God as we wait for the one who makes all things whole.

Reader 1: This is the song the angels proclaimed: "Peace on earth, and mercy mild, God and sinners reconciled."

Reader 2: Jesus came to reconcile us to God, to offer us peace from the inside out: peace deeper than fear, peace stronger than division, peace that nothing can shatter. His birth announces a kingdom where God's glory shines, where all creation is restored, where every wound is healed.

Congregation: Glory to the King of Kings! Come, Lord Jesus—bring your peace to us and to your world.

Reader 1: Today we light the **Candle of Peace**—a sign of God's promise, a reminder of the angels' song, and a prayer for God's peace to come again and again.

(The Candle of Peace is lit.)

Reader 2: Come, Lord Jesus, Prince of Peace.

Congregation: Shine your peace in our hearts, in your church, and in your world. Amen.
