Expectations

We believe there are some things that will help make this the most positive experience possible. The following expectations should be taken seriously and are designed to help us all commit to growing during our confirmation class.

- **Class participation** – Students should attend all Wednesday evening classes from 6:00 to 7:00pm. If a class is missed, you will need to make it up with Trentell before attending the next scheduled class. **You can only miss 2** classes before you are asked to take confirmation next year. When you are in class, we expect you to be fully present and engaged (participating in activities, discussion, etc.)
- **Church involvement** – Horizons members are expected to be involved in our church. For our youth, this means attending worship, Fusion Sunday mornings, and midweek/other youth events.
- **Serving** – Horizons members are encouraged to be open to how God wants them to use their spiritual gifts.
- **Fusion Retreat** - Our retreat in the spring is a requirement for confirmation class.
- **Outside classroom involvement** – All students are required to do **4 hours** of community service. They can count 30 minutes of each Fusion midweek night if they would like to use that. Here are some alternate ideas are:

 - Humane Society
 - Helping a neighbor with yard work, housework, etc.
- **At-home component** – We will be reading a Bible plan together as a group and completion is required for class. We will be using the Bible app if your student doesn't have phone or tablet, we will provide a paper copy of the bible plan.
