Joshua 12-Judges 16

In Joshua 12–24, Joshua got instructions to distribute the remaining land among the tribes, despite much of it still being unconquered.

Joshua delivers a message "Choose you this day who you will serve... As for me and my house we will serve the Lord." This is not just about who we will serve, but it's a conscious decision to serve the Lord exclusively, turning away from idols. Joshua warns the people if you choose idols, you will face the consequences.

After the death of Joshua, an angel came to warn the Israelites, because of their disobedience and sinning (worshiping other gods), There WILL be consequences.

Judges teaches us about the dangers of sin and compromising vows. That is how Samson's lust and pride led to his downfall. Yet God had persistent grace for him to accomplish more in his death than in his life. As a warning of giving into temptation and God's ability to work through imperfect people.
