Your continued support will build upon all the ways we've collectively invested in the life of this faith community over the past three years. God has graciously supported St. Stephen through continued and sustained growth. Our worship services continue to see growth. New families continue to find a home here. Each Sunday, we welcome new guests who take essential next steps in their faith journeys.

With God's continued blessings and your investments in our church life, we have continued to pour love and resources into the areas where we are seeing the most creative energy and need, like:

- Another year of at-capacity Vacation Bible School, with more than 100 children most of whose families are not affiliated with St. Stephen
- Increased engagement opportunities to reach those families, like our joint fall festival with the preschool and our Disney family movie nights (our most recent attracted more people than ever some 50 or more children and parents!)
- Sustained adult discipleship programs, small groups, and mission opportunities, like this fall's smorgasbord of more than a dozen individual offerings
- More than a solid year and a half of Common Table evangelism that reaches beyond our four walls and has now touched the lives of over 150 people

These seeds, and many more, were planted with your past giving. We've had the benefit of enjoying some of the fruits of this labor, like our associate pastor Jesse's recent transition from half-time to full-time. But we still have more to harvest — more individuals, families, and children to reach, more unchurched and church-curious folks to encourage, more disciples like you to equip.

The investments we've made year over year are bearing good fruit — a testament to your own commitment and belief in this special place. It is our hope that you will be inspired to join us in this season of harvest again, as we prepare to enter 2026 for more planting, more sowing, more growing toward Christ and his kingdom "on earth as it is in heaven." With your help and God's direction, St. Stephen will continue to be a church where the hands, feet, and heart of Jesus Christ are felt directly in the lives of people on our campus, in our neighborhood, throughout the city of Charlotte, and beyond.
