Psalm 112:1-6 - The righteous are remembered forever  
Matthew 7:24-25 - The wise build on a firm foundation  
2 Timothy 1:5 - Faith passed down through generations

In Conclusion - None of this matters without faith, belief, and hope in Jesus Christ. All of these qualities could add up to make you a very good person by society's standards, but would ultimately fall short unless we are living them out as a response to what Jesus did for us on the cross.

A Life that embodies Proverbs and Honors Moms

Happy Mother's Day to all mothers, grandmothers, stepmoms, spiritual moms, and even to women who mentor and disciple others. We love you! We are so grateful for you, and we don't celebrate you enough.

To highlight Moms this weekend, we will be walking all throughout the book of Proverbs, specifically using Proverbs 31:10-31 as our starting point. This passage is targeted directly at 'The Woman Who Feels the Lord', but the lessons learned in this passage (and throughout the whole book) are for all of us!

**Wisdom begins beneath the surface (the fear of the Lord)** Proverbs 31:30

This is the foundation of everything- not personality, productivity, or even morality.

Proverbs 1:7 - The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge  
Proverbs 9:10 - The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom  
Proverbs 8:13 - To fear the Lord is to hate evil  
Ecclesiastes 12:13 - Fear God and keep His commandments  
Psalm 111:10 - The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom

**Wisdom works hard.** (Diligence with purpose)  
Proverbs 31:13-19, 27

This passage is filled with motion- working, planning, building, providing.

Proverbs 6:6-11 - Learn from the ant  
Proverbs 10:4 - Lazy hands vs. diligent hands  
Proverbs 12:24 - The diligent will rule  
Proverbs 13:4 - The diligent are fully satisfied  
Proverbs 14:23 - All hard work brings profit  
Proverbs 21:5 - Plans of the diligent lead to abundance  
Colossians 3:23 - Work heartily as for the Lord

**Wisdom builds others.** (Words and Compassion)  
Proverbs 31:20, 26
