Growing Notes

The Heart of Giving (v1-5). Why is readiness important to joyful giving? How does enthusiasm for generosity influence others?

The Hilarious Giver (v7). What does it mean to give “not reluctantly or under compulsion”? In your own life, what hinders cheerful giving? What helps you become a more joyful giver?

The Supernatural Law of Multiplication (v6). How have you seen “you reap what you sow” play out spiritually or practically? Why do you think generosity multiplies joy and not just resources?

God’s Abundant Provision (v8-11). How does knowing God supplies “all grace” change the way you view giving? Where do you struggle to trust God with provision?

The Impact of Generosity (v12-15). How does generosity lead others to thanksgiving? How does giving connect us more deeply to the body of Christ?

Challenge: How does Jesus’ generosity toward us shape our generosity toward others (2Cor.8:9)? What is one step of generosity God might be prompting you to take this week? Pray.

Jesus is the epitome of generosity! People who are recipients of His infinite and eternal generosity naturally become “cheerful” givers. Paul describes that kind of giving with the Greek word hilaros (v7)—where we get the English word “hilarious.” It is a kind of giving that erupts with joy. Not pressure. Not guilt. Not Obligation. But hilarity because of how rich we have become by grace through faith in Christ Jesus. God is greater than my highs and lows so I can give freely, joyfully, hilariously!

HILARIOUS GIVING...

BEGINS WITH A READY HEART (v1-5)

Generosity flows from a heart that is intentional , not impulsive; prepared , not pressured. It should be a part of your budget and recordkeeping.

Five Biblical Principles of Wise Financial Management: Budget (Luke 14:28), Recordkeeping (Pro.27:23-24), True Wealth (Matt.6:19-20), Self-control (Pro.25:28), Generosity (2Cor.9:6-7).

GIVES WITH A RIGHT HEART (v6-11)

- Gives expectantly . Gal.6:7-9
v6 The point is this: whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows bountifully will also reap bountifully.

Paul isn’t manipulating; he’s describing the supernatural law of multiplication . Luke 6:38; Pro.22:9; Mal.3:10-12
“Put me to the test, says the LORD of Hosts.”

- Gives Thoughtfully . v7a Each one must give as he has decided in his heart,
- Gives Willingly . v7b not reluctantly or under compulsion,
- Gives Cheerfully . v7c for God loves a cheerful giver.
