

Key Truth: Worship is not just what we do on Sundays—it's who we live for every day. A fully devoted life is a God centered life !

Application:

- **Fellowship** is positioning your heart before God.
- **Discipleship** is being filled with God's truth.
- **Ministry** is pouring out what God has poured in.
- **Evangelism** is turning the world's attention toward Jesus.
- And **Worship** is the reason for it all: not that people would look at us... but that they would see Him.

So the goal isn't to shine so people say, "Wow, what a Christian."
The goal is to shine so people say, "Wow, what a Savior."

Because the fully devoted Christian understands:
My life is not the source—it's the reflection.
All glory belongs to God!

Closing Challenge

Ask yourself two questions:

What is my next step in becoming a fully devoted follower of Christ?
Who or what is getting the glory of my life?

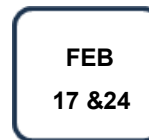

Fully devoted: A 5-G Life in Christ

The Genuine Christian (Walks with God) Fellowship
The Growing Christian (Lives God's Word) Discipleship
The Giving Christian (Contributes to God's Work) Ministry
The Going Christian (Makes an impact in this World) Evangelism
The Glorifying Christian (Doing it all for God's Glory) Worship

Everyone lives for something. What you glorify shapes how you live. The fully devoted Christian lives **all of life** for **the glory of God** (1 Cor.10:31). Being Fully Devoted (5-G) to God (His Glory) and Fullness of Life in God (Our Satisfaction) are one in the same pursuit (John 10:10). God is most Gloried in us when we are most Satisfied in Him. When we are most satisfied in Him sin loses its deceptive appeal and suffering loses its dis-illusional effect.

Big Idea: Worship is not just one of the G's—it is the fuel and purpose of all of them. We aren't Genuine, Growing, Giving, and Going to be seen by people...We do it all because **God is Worthy**.

The 5-G Life Reframed Through Worship

- **Genuine (Fellowship):** We walk with God because we treasure His presence. (Ps.16:11)
- **Growing (Discipleship):** We live by God's Word because we love His truth. (Jn.8:31-32)
- **Giving (Ministry):** We contribute joyfully because He first gave to us. (2Cor.8:9)
- **Going (Evangelism):** We make Christ known because His glory deserves witnesses. (Acts 1:8)
- **Glorifying (Worship):** The aim of everything: Latin – Soli Deo Gloria (Glory to God alone). (Rom.11:36)
