

THURSDAY – The Servant King Matthew 26:17–75; John 13
Jesus is the **servant** King who gave Himself for us, so we will want to walk in humility, surrender, and **sacrificial love**. Isa.53:5; Phil.2:3-5

FRIDAY – The Crucified King (Good Friday) Matthew 27
Jesus is the **sacrificial Lamb** who died for our sin, so we will want to respond with **repentance** and **trust** in His grace. 2Cor.5:21; Rom.5:8

SATURDAY – The Waiting King Matthew 27:57–66
Jesus is at work even in the **silence**, so we will want to trust God’s **faithfulness** when we cannot see what He is doing. Isa.55:8-9; Lam.3:35-36

SUNDAY – The Risen King (Easter) Matthew 28
Jesus is the **Risen** and **Victorious** King, so we will want to live in the hope, power, and **New Life** of His resurrection. 1Cor.15:55-57; Rom.6:4

The question is not simply what happened that week.
The question is: **What will you do with Jesus?**
Will Jesus be just someone you admire...
or the **King you passionately follow?**
Because these seven days didn’t just change history.
They changed **Eternity!**

- Which day of the Holy Week did you find your response Convicting?
- Which day of the Holy Week did you find most Comforting?
- What is one step you will take this next week to respond to Jesus more fully as you reflect more deeply on Holy Week?

The week between **Palm Sunday and Resurrection Sunday**.
Seven days that would change **eternity for every human being who would ever live**.

Holy Week is not just history, but Holy Moments we can step into. A Holy Moment is when God makes Himself known and invites you to respond. Holy Week is not just something we remember—it's something we enter. Each day is an invitation to meet Jesus and respond (Holy Moments).

DAY-BY-DAY: THE FINAL WEEK OF JESUS SUNDAY – The King's Triumphal Entry (Palm Sunday)

Matthew 21:1–11

Jesus is the promised King who came in humility to save, so we will want to surrender to Him as He is, not as we want Him to be.
Zechariah 9:9; Luke 9:23

MONDAY – The King Cleans the Temple Matthew 21:12–22

Jesus is the Holy Lord who purifies true worship, so we will want to give Him our hearts that are genuine and fruitful, not just religious activity.
Malachi 3:1-3; John 4:23-24

TUESDAY – The King Teaches Matthew 21-25

Jesus is the authoritative teacher and coming Judge, so we will want to live faithfully and be ready for His Return. John 12:48; Matt.24:44

WEDNESDAY – The King Is Betrayed Matthew 26:1–16

Jesus is the faithful Savior who endured betrayal, so we will want to move beyond outward closeness and truly surrender our hearts to Him.
