

Paul lists seven things that he saw as evidence of their true repentance.

1. **Earnestness** – eagerness to make things right.
2. **Eagerness to clear yourselves** – desire for integrity.
3. **Indignation** – hatred of sin.
4. **Alarm** – holy fear of God.
5. **Longing** – renewed desire for relationship.
6. **Concern** – care for others harmed by sin.
7. **Readiness to see justice done** – commitment to do what's right.

Growing Notes

- 1) What words or ideas first come to mind when you thinking of repentance? How does this compare to the biblical definition of repentance?
- 2) When you felt a conviction over sin how did it feel? What moved it between conviction and condemnation?
- 3) When you think of the outward expression of repentance has there been a time when someone said the right words to indicate repentance? Did they seem genuine? What made you think one way or the other?
- 4) After a time of true repentance what did you feel in your heart? How did it affect your life?
- 5) Have you ever struggled after repenting and receiving forgiveness to forgive yourself? What about an ongoing sin that you struggle with?

What do you think of when you hear the word repentance? You likely connect thoughts of shame, judgement, and mostly other negative thoughts. The reality is the Bible's definition of repentance doesn't bring shame, but connection, forgiveness and restoration.

The adversary has twisted biblical repentance into something we avoid to keep us isolated and separated from God.
