KINGDOM CULTURE The Gospel of Matthew “Treasures in Heaven” (Matthew 6:19-24)

Talk of money can be fraught with many cultural and personal landmines. Our past lived experiences heavily color our view of it and relationship with it. Our culture loudly proclaims its own idea about money, its value to us, and how it shapes our identity

Jesus starts from a different perspective: where is our treasure? Our relationship and how we see God and money in our life will impact not only our view of the world, but will dictate how we live.

The Treasure

- The problem is when money becomes our **Savior**.
- When God is our savior, money becomes a **Servant**.

The Eye

- What we treasure changes our **perception**.
- A heart that trusts God **gives**; a heart that trusts money **grips**.

The Master

- Whatever I can't let go of isn't my **possession**, it's my **master**.
- If God isn't my provider, **I must be**.
- Your actions **reveal** the master you've already **chosen**.
