

What Difference Will I Make?

Intimacy With God Will Give Me...

Dignity (Why do I matter?)

Your worth comes from being known and loved by God, not from your performance, possessions, or popularity (Matt.4:1-11; 1Jn.2:15-17). God names you beloved, child, heir, and friend (Eph.1:6; Rom.8:15-17; John 15:15).

Delight (What truly satisfies me?)

God Himself becomes your joy, not merely His gifts. Your heart longs to enjoy God's presence, not just relief from problems. Desire is satisfied, not suppressed! (Ps.73:25; Ps.16:11; John 6:35)

Daily Walk (How should I live?)

Ongoing relational awareness, conversation, dependence, and repentance, not religious busyness or withdrawal from responsibilities. (Ps.105:4; Ps.139:7-10; 1Thess.5:17; Pro.3:5-6; 1John 1:7-9)

Devoted Family (Where do I belong?)

Critical Truth: Personal intimacy with God was never meant to exist in isolation. We encounter Christ in one another, spiritual growth happens best with one another, and encouragement/accountability protect us against discouragement/deception. (Acts 2:42; Ephesians 2:19, 4:14-16; Hebrews 3:12-13)

Growing Notes

Personal Fellowship: When you hear the phrase "walking with God," what comes to mind? How would you describe your current walk?

Identity & Dignity: How does finding your dignity in intimacy with God challenge the way you usually measure your worth (performance, possessions, popularity)?

Delight & Desire: What competes most for your delight right now? How does fellowship with God reshape what you want?

Daily Practice: Which aspect of daily fellowship do you most need to grow in: awareness, conversation, dependence, or returning to God? Why?

Community & Church: Why do you think God designed spiritual growth to happen in the context of a local church rather than in isolation?

Commitment: What is one practical step you can take this year to deepen your fellowship with God and your connection to the church family? Pray.

Full Devotion to God (His Glory) and Fullness of Life in God (Our Satisfaction) are one in the same pursuit.

2026 Challenge: Become what you were created to be—Fully Devoted: A 5-G Life In Christ!

Series Theme: A fully devoted follower of Jesus is GENUINE (Walks with God), GROWING (lives His Word), GIVING (contributes to His work), GOING (makes an impact in this world), GLORIFYING (doing all of this for God's Glory).

The GENUINE Christian: Walks With God (Fellowship) 1Jn.1:3-7

Big Idea: A Genuine Christian is not merely someone who believes in God, but someone who walks with God daily in loving fellowship, and that fellowship is personally cultivated and communally nurtured in the life of the local church.

What On Earth Am I Primarily Here For?

I was Created for intimate relationship (Fellowship) with my CREATOR! (Why Do I Exist?)

- You were made personal, not merely functional. (Genesis 1:26-27; 3:8; 5:22, 24)
- You were designed to live face to face with God. (Numbers 6:24-26; John 15:4; Revelation 21:3)
- Sin broke intimacy, not God's desire for it. (2 Corinthians 5:18-19)
- Salvation is relational before it is behavioral. (John 3:16; Rom.10:9; John 17:3)
