- The Result: This gives us both <a href="https://humility\_ninful">humility\_ninful</a> (sinful) and <a href="https://econfidence">confidence</a> (loved), which frees us from both legalism and license.
- Insight: The gospel creates a third way—not religious performance nor irreligious freedom—but <u>joyful</u> obedience motivated by <u>love</u> not fear or pride (self-righteousness).

### **Checklist for a Gospel-Centered Balanced Life (1 Corinthians 8)**

- ✓ Is your knowledge growing your <u>love</u>. (v1)
- ✓ Are you <u>humble</u> in what you think you know? (v2)
- ✓ Are you grounded in a <u>relationship</u> with God, not just ideas? (v3)
- ✓ Do you understand the difference between non-essential and essential doctrine? (v8)
- ✓ Are you concerned about your <u>influence</u> on weaker believers?
   (v9)
- Do you see your actions through the lens of <u>Christ's sacrifice</u>? (v11)
- ✓ Are you willing to <u>sacrifice</u> your freedoms for the Gospel's sake? (v13)

# **Growing Notes**

When you hear the word "freedom," what comes to mind? Have you ever experienced a church background that leaned more toward legalism or license? How did it shape your view of God?

What are the lies of legalism and liberalism and how do they rob you of the power of the Gospel? What is Gospel liberty? What is the key to a Gospel-centered balanced life?

Read 1 Corinthians 8. Paul addresses a specific issue—eating food offered to idols—but the principles he teaches create a kind of checklist that keeps us grounded in the gospel. Review the check lists. Which one(s) are strengths and which one(s) are growth areas for you? What are some steps you can take to become more Gospel-centered? What specific truths about the Gospel do you need to preach to yourself this week? Pray.

"Two Thieves of True Freedom" (1 Corinthians 8:1-13)

The Gospel is endlessly fascinating, forever captivating, and never boring (1Pet.1:12). Nothing can transform a human heart, heal a wounded soul, and satisfy our deepest longing like the Gospel (Rom.1:16-17). But nothing can keep you from the Liberating power of the Gospel like these two thieves: Legalism and Liberalism. If you're not progressively (through the years) being transformed, healed, and satisfied by the Gospel then chances are that one of these two thieves are robbing you of the most liberating and satisfying quality of life you could ever live (John 17:3).

# Legalism: The Lie That We Earn God's Approval. (Gal.2:16; Col.2:20-23)

- Definition: Legalism is the belief that we are accepted by God <u>based</u> on our performance, rule-keeping, or religious behavior.
- The Error: It denies the <u>sufficiency</u> of Christ's work and subtly shifts trust from Christ to self.
- Warning: Legalism produces <u>pride</u> (if we think we're succeeding) or <u>despair</u> (if we think we're failing). Either way, it robs the believer of the assurance, joy, and liberty found in Christ.

# Liberalism (or License): The Lie That Grace Means Freedom to Sin. (Rom.6:1-2; Jude 1:4)

- Definition: Liberalism (or antinomianism) is the belief that because we're saved by grace, how we live <u>doesn't matter</u>.
- The Error: It denies the transforming power of grace and ignores God's call to <u>holiness</u> and <u>obedience</u>.
- Warning: This view <u>cheapens grace</u> and undermines the seriousness of sin. It fails to understand that true grace leads to change.

The Gospel (Liberty): True Freedom through Grace. (Gal.5:13; John 1:17; Rom.8:1-4)

Definition: The gospel says we are more <u>sinful</u> than we ever dared believe, yet more <u>loved</u> than we ever dared to dream.
