# **Beholding** His Glory

To behold means more than just to *see*—it means to gaze upon with attention, admiration, and affection.

The glory of God is the visible, radiant expression of God's character and presence.

### We Become Whole

To become whole means to be restored to the image and likeness of Christ, the perfect image of God.

Mental and Emotional brokenness often comes from <u>false images</u> — of God, of ourselves, or of the world:

- We see God as harsh instead of gracious. Ex.34:6
- We see ourselves as worthless instead of beloved . Jn17:23
- We see the world as chaos instead of under God's care. Isa.54:10

#### When we behold Christ:

- Shame gives way to <u>acceptance</u>. Rom.8:1
- Fear gives way to <u>trust</u>. 1John 4:18
- Chaos gives way to <u>peace</u>. Isa.26:3-4
- Self-hatred gives way to <u>gratitude</u>. Ps.139:14

Seeing and Savoring God's Glory restores a right view of reality — and that's the foundation of mental and emotional health (Wholeness/Holiness/Christlikeness).

# God is > My Highs/Lows

"Becoming Whole" (2Cor.3:1-18)

We live in a very broken world filled with sin and suffering. None of us are exempt. But the Gospel (Christ Jesus) can transform us, heal us, and satisfy us—making us whole like nothing else!

Wholeness (Holiness/Christlikeness) is the most pleasurable and exhilarating quality of life in existence. We are called to live fascinated in the superior pleasures of experiencing God's love for us and our love for Him that overflows into loving people (1Pet.1:16).

<u>Background:</u> Paul isn't just teaching theology—he's defending his ministry. Some people (likely Judaizers) were criticizing Paul for not having "letters of recommendation" or for not keeping the old Mosaic customs. They were trying to pull believers back under the old covenant system of law.

**WHAT GOD DOES:** (v1-16) A covenant relationship with God is unilateral: He initiates it, He implements it, and He guarantees it. The only role we play is to either to accept it or reject it.

# God Changes Hearts . (v1–3)

"You yourselves are our letter of recommendation, written on our hearts, to be known and read by all. And you show that you are a letter from Christ delivered by us, written not with ink but with the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone but on tablets of human hearts." (v2-3) John 16:8-11; 2Cor.5:14-15

# God Gives Life . (v4–6)

"(God) who has made us sufficient to be ministers of a new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit. For the letter kills, but the <u>Spirit gives life</u>." (v6) John 14:6; John 17:3; Jer.9:23-24

# God Makes Us More and More Glorious . (v7-16)

"For if what was being brought to an end came with glory, <u>much more will</u> what is permanent have glory." (v11) Prov.4:18-19

### **HOW GOD DOES IT:** (v17-18)

"Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, <u>there is freedom</u>. And we all, with unveiled face, <u>beholding the glory</u> of the Lord, are <u>being transformed</u> into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit." (v17-18)
