Application: You can build your life on God’s Word. Matt.24:35

V. What Does Real Trust Look Like? Joseph Shows Us

1. Real Trust Feels the Pain but Chooses Righteousness. (v.18-19)
2. Real Trust Believes in the King’s Identity. (v.20-23)
3. Real Trust Obeys Immediately and Completely. (v.24)
4. Real Trust Accepts Cost and Risk. (v.24-25)
5. Real Trust Aligns with God’s Redemptive Mission. (v.25)

**Kingdom Culture is not built on hype.
It is built on Trust in a Faithful King!**

A King Like No Other

Ray Davis

The King's Arrival (Matthew 1:18-25)
Section: The King We've Been Waiting For (Matthew 1-4)

This is the King's arrival.
And Matthew is showing us that this King is **unlike any other king in history**—and that He is **A King We Can Truly Trust**.

Big Idea: Jesus is the perfect Mediator, loving Savior, intimate Friend, and faithful Promise Keeper—and trusting Him transforms everything about how we live.

I. The King as Perfect Mediator – Fully God and Fully Man

“That which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit.” (v. 20)

Theologians call this the **hypostatic union**—Jesus is fully God and fully man in one person. 1Tim.2:5; John 14:6

Application: You are praying to a King who **understands** you fully and **represents** you perfectly before God. Heb.4:15-16; 1Jn.2:1

II. The King as Loving Savior – “He Will Save His People”

“You shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins.” (v. 21)

Jesus literally means “**The Lord saves.**”

Application: You fight sin **from victory**, not for victory. Rom.5:8, 10

III. The King as Intimate Friend – “God With Us”

“They shall call His name Immanuel (which means, God with us).” (v. 23)

Application: Christianity is not just belief. It is **relationship** and **presence**. Matt.1:23, 28:20
