Resurrection 101:

- Jesus' resurrection body is the <u>prototype</u> of what believers will experience ("first fruits").
- Believers' resurrection bodies are <u>related to</u> but <u>different</u> <u>from</u> current earthly bodies.
- Believers' resurrection bodies are proof that Jesus defeated death so that death <u>could not defeat us</u>!

Because of Jesus' resurrection, the Corinthian believers have a reason for unity (1-4), motivation for sexual purity (5-7), power to love others more than themselves (8-14), and victory over death (15)

That's the life-changing reality of the Gospel!

Growing Notes

When you were younger, what were some of your earliest thoughts about what resurrection bodies will be like? What did you secretly hope to be true?

What arguments *in opposition* to the resurrection of Jesus have you experienced? How have those arguments been defeated?

Read together 1 Corinthians 15:12-19. In this passage Paul lists seven hypothetical consequences of denying Jesus' resurrection (see if you can find all seven). How would you summarize Paul's argument for why the resurrection matters for followers of Jesus? How might this bring you confidence and assurance?

Considering Paul's instructions from chapter 15, how should we approach our lives now given the reality of a coming resurrection? How can a future resurrection provide comfort and hope in the present?

Death Isn't the End (1Corinthians 15)

All of us wonder what life will be like after this life. As the apostle Paul reaches the end of his letter to the Corinthian church, he addresses an indispensable part of the Gospel- the resurrection of Jesus. *How does Jesus' resurrection produce a future hope for his followers?*

The issue: Some in the church rejected the reality of resurrection

Paul's Gospel response: The Gospel = Jesus...

Died Buried Raised Appeared

Evidence for Jesus' resurrection:

- The <u>empty tomb</u>
- The documented appearances
- The <u>disciples' testimony</u>

If the Resurrection is not true, there's no reason to follow Jesus.

If the Resurrection is true, there's no reason to reject Jesus.
