KNOW GOD

What if instead of spending large amounts of time developing a long list of changes, we slowed down to get away with God, and discover one word to take into a new year? One word that most captures who God is inviting you to become. One word that serves as a lens through which you see and embrace God's work and grace this year. One word for one year!

In order to discover your one word, here is a simple process we hope you will find helpful.

PREPARE YOUR HEART

The first step is to prepare your heart by taking time to clear the clutter, eliminate the noise, and create space to take a good look inward. You will want to find a quiet place with no disctractions or interruptions. Once you have identified your space, take time to do the following ...

- RFFI FCT

The goal is to align your heart before God. Look back on the previous year and express gratitude to God for various experiences and adventures that shaped your life. Also, create room to confess to God anything that you know doesn't align with His desires for your life. Be ruthlessly honest. Befriend silence. Breathe. Align your heart. Go slow. As Dallas Willard said, "Hurriedness is the enemy of the soul."

As you slow down to reflect consider the following questions to serve as a guide in the process of your preparing your heart for a new year.

WHERE DID YOU SEE GOD AT WORK LAST YEAR?
WHAT EXPERIENCES SHAPED YOUR LIFE LAST YEAR?
WHAT AREAS OF YOUR LIFE ARE OUT OF ALIGNMENT
WITH GOD?

After taking time to slow down in silence, solitude, and reflection, you are ready to move forward in the second step of the process.

Discover Your Word

The second step is to discover your word through engaging in prayer, reading God's Word, and looking ahead to a new year. The goal is not to get a good word, but to get a God word. Don't rush the process. You may have a million words running through your mind, but ask God to place one word on your heart.

- PRAYERFULLY ENGAGE IN GOD'S WORD

Prayerfully engage in God's Word. I suggest having a Bible reading plan that will help you stay focused and encouraged throughout the year. As you are reading, underline and highlight anything that stands out to you. We want our one word for the year to be rooted in God's character and God's Word. God speaks to us in several ways, but the most consistent way is through His Word.

As you slow down to pray and engage in God's Word ask the following questions to serve as a guide in the process of discovering your one word. WHO DO I SENSE GOD IS LEADING ME TO BECOME THIS YFAR? WHERE ARE AREAS I NEED TO GROW? WHAT WORDS COME TO MIND WHEN YOU THINK OF THIS NEW YEAR?

At this point in the process you have a list of words. Take a moment to write down a few of them. Spend some more time in prayer and select a word!

You are almost finished! The next step is to take a few days to process your word through some helpful filters.

Helpful Filters

- FILTER IT THROUGH GOD'S WORD

Does your word align with God's Word? The answer at this point should be, "yes." Yet, it's important to take time to consider this question even further. If we want to know God's heart for our life it is revealed to us in His Son, and in His Word. Ask yourself, "Does this word align with God's heart for me life?"

- FILTER IT THROUGH GOD'S PEOPLE

Ask people who you know are doing life with God to give you honest feedback. Listen to what they have to say to you. Allow it to be a source of encouragement and clarity.

You have discovered your one word! It's exciting to enter into a new year with a new word!

Learn, Grow, Share

Now that you have your word, take a few moments to consider how you can make sure your word is in sight and in mind. Maybe put it on the dashboard of your car, save it to your desktop or consider another place that you will see it throughout the year.

Making a plan to learn and grow around your word by reading books, interviewing others or having unique experiences. When you know your word, you know how to grow intentionally this year!

Last but not least, look for ways to share your word. God blesses us to be a blessing to others. If God gives you a word it is not just for you! It is also important to invite trusted people into your life to partner with you through prayer around your word.

Take time to make a plan as you go forward into this new year. Make it simple, clear, and intentional.
