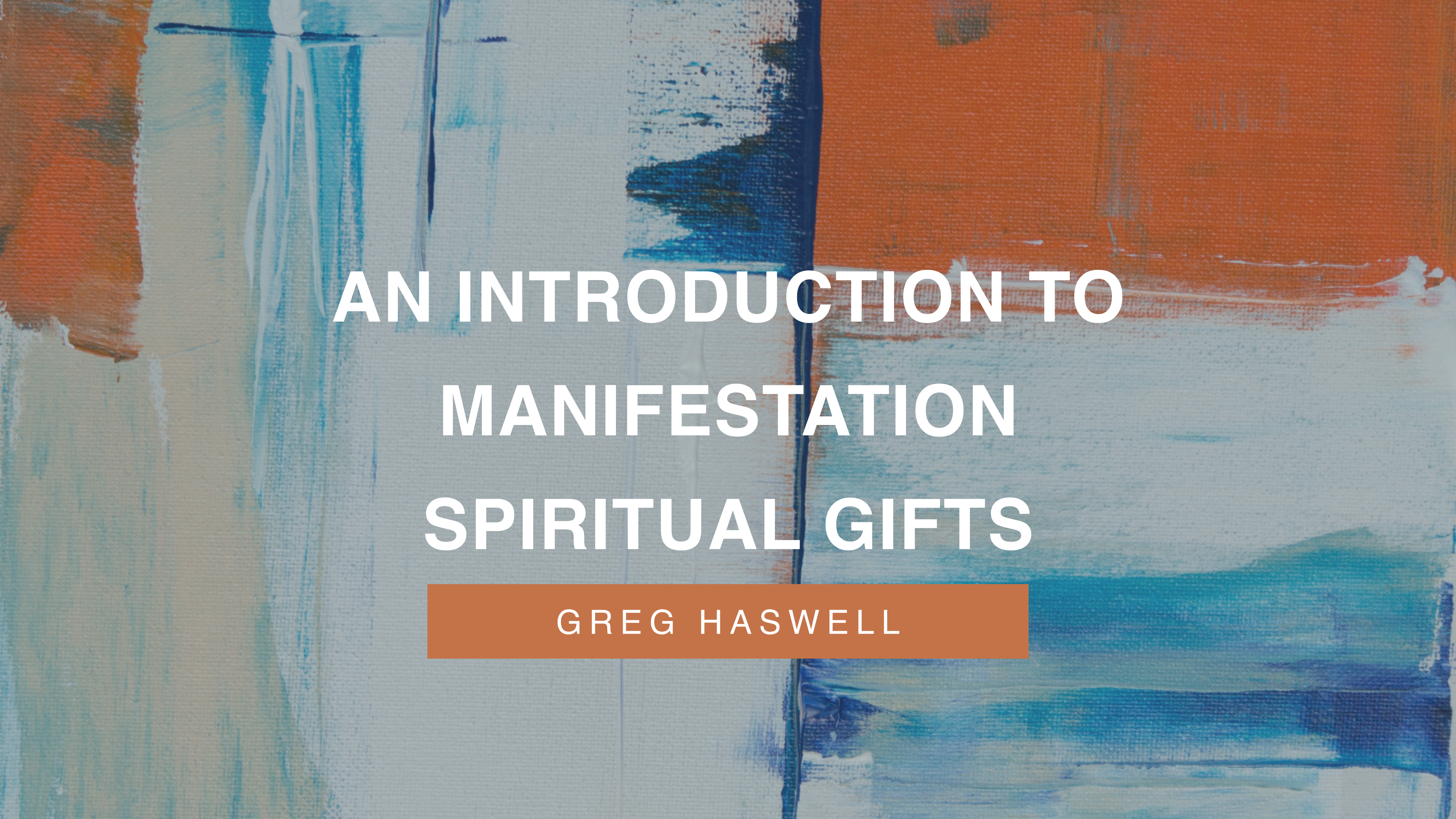




AN INTRODUCTION TO MANIFESTATION SPIRITUAL GIFTS

- Lists of spiritual gifts are mentioned in the New Testament. These lists comprise 3 sets of gifts.
- Each type or set of spiritual gifts has a list dedicated to it that outlines its administration and working
- Some lists have all the different types of gifts mixed together but no sets are alike

- Types of spiritual gifts
- Each type or set of spiritual gifts is given by and associated with a member of the Godhead
- Each set of gifts is distributed by Holy Spirit, in service of Jesus, and given to work in us by God the Father

- **FATHER** - Enabling favor demonstrated in practical abilities given to each one.
- **SON** - Skilled servants given to prepare His bride for His return. Not all are called to be these gifts.
- **HOLY SPIRIT** - Power to make the nature and will of God manifest. Available to everyone who is born again.

3 TYPES OF SPIRITUAL GIFTS - THE FATHER GIVES

- **Charismata** - A divine gratuity, a spiritual endowment, religious qualification, miraculous faculty, a free gift.
- We have different gifts (charismata), according to the grace (charis) given to each of us. - **Romans 12:6**
- But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: “God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble.” - **James 4:6 (NKJV)**

3 TYPES OF SPIRITUAL GIFTS - JESUS GIVES

- **Doma** - meaning a present, a gift
- 8 “When he ascended on high, he took many captives and gave gifts (Doma) to his people.” . . . 11 So Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers - **Ephesians 4:8,11**

3 TYPES OF SPIRITUAL GIFTS - HOLY SPIRIT GIVES

- **Phanerosis** - an exhibition, expression, a bestowment, a manifestation
- Now to each one the manifestation (phanerosis) of the Spirit is given for the common good.- **1 Corinthians 12:7**

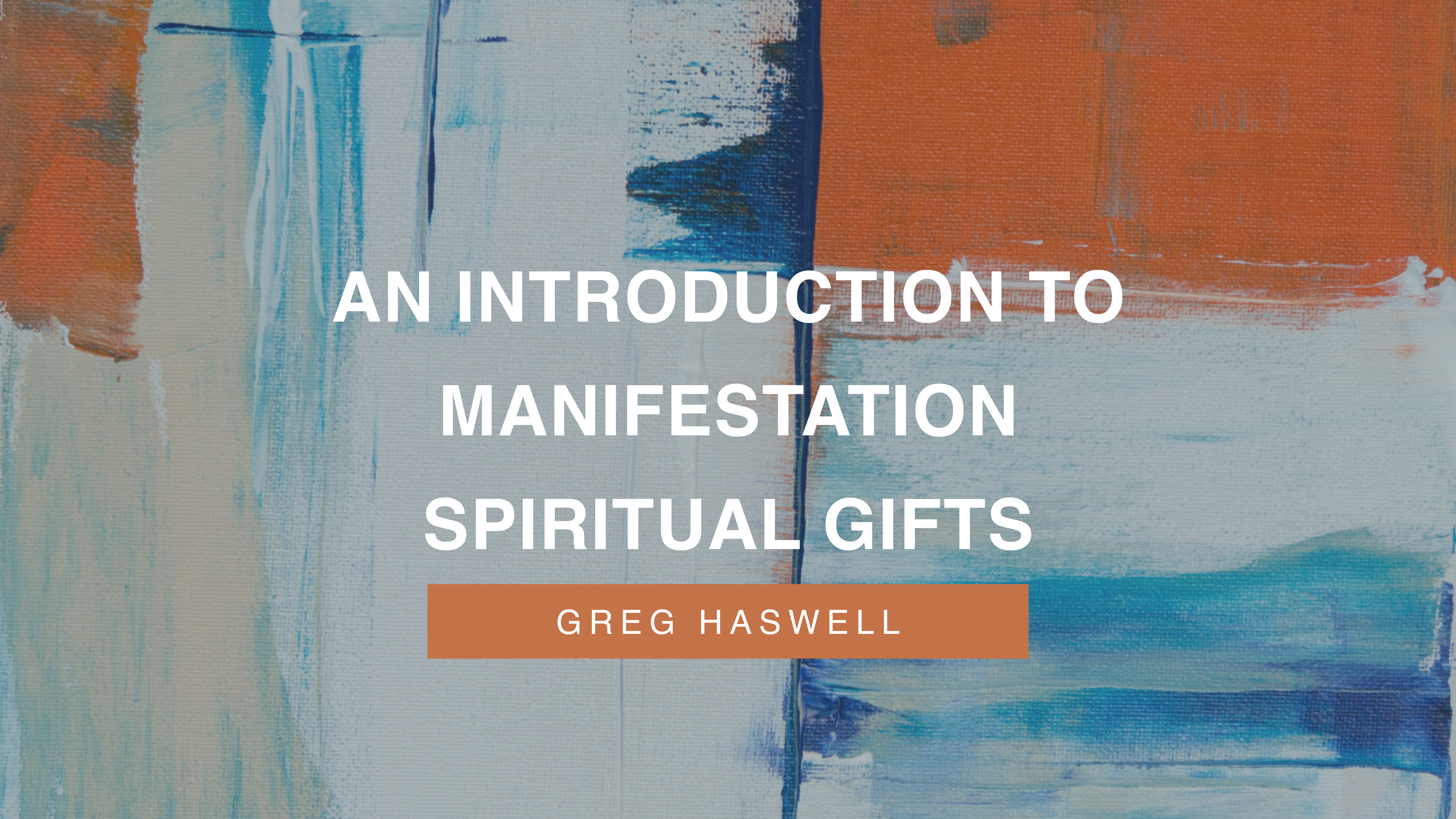

1. Eagerly desire them - **1 Corinthians 12:31, 14:1**
2. Be bold in them - **1 Corinthians 14:30**
3. Be as clear as possible with them - **1 Corinthians 14:7-12**

9 IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT THEM

1. They don't reflect maturity
2. The Holy Spirit uses the furnishings of our minds
3. They should be eagerly desired
4. They are for the benefit of all
5. Ignorance and immature use can lead to harmful meetings
6. Clarity and simplicity are most effective ingredients (Orderly)
7. They are to be judged by the congregation and leaders
8. Their timing and style can be controlled
9. We owe lost people consideration



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
