International prayer support:

Iran - Positive outcomes from the possible two-week ceasefire in Iran.

Nigeria - "At least 33 people have been killed and many kidnapped in fresh attacks over the Easter weekend in northern Nigeria. It comes a week after [at least 27 people were killed on Palm Sunday](#) in a predominantly Christian village in Plateau State. On Christian communities of Mbalom and Mbasombo, Benue State, killing 26 people. It

transformed a day of celebration, peace and reflection into mourning and displacement. On the same day, two churches in Ariko village, Kaduna State, were attacked.... Christians weren't the only ones vulnerable to attack in Nigeria over Easter. In Zamfara State, bandits kidnapped more than 150 people from rural villages which are not Christian-majority. Most are women and children. Other residents fled, leaving villages largely deserted."

Please pray:

- For peace for the grieving families and congregations, and for strength to hold onto Jesus
- For the safety, well-being and imminent release of all those kidnapped, that the authorities will have the willpower and actions to bring the perpetrators to justice, and for the violence in northern Nigeria to cease
- For wisdom and strength for church leaders as they seek to care for their flocks and guide them through this hugely difficult time." (Source: www.opendoorsuk.org)
