GROWING SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOODS IN WEST TIMOR. West Timor is the poorest province in Indonesia, and people's ability to better their lives is limited by their ability to earn an income. ... Waluwanja gets up for work every day at 5am. After a drink of hot coffee, he's straight into his back garden, clearing out weeds, watering each plant and making sure no pests are getting in. He grows all sorts of vegetables, but lately he's been testing out mustard greens, carrots and rice paddies, which he will sell wholesale to street vendors in his community. When a crop becomes ready for harvest, he cleans, prepares and delivers the produce direct to his customers one by one.

Waluwanja learned how to run a productive garden business through <u>UnitingWorld</u>'s partner TLM in West Timor. In one of the poorest provinces in Indonesia, TLM acknowledge that people's ability to improve their lives and their communities depends on opportunities to earn a sustainable income.
