- Joseph has died and we find the Hebrew people have multiplied into a great nation of people.

## Exodus 32-34

- Important section of Scripture.
- Like a Genesis 3 moment for Israel
- While Moses is up on the mountain with God, in Chapter 32, we find the people down at the bottom of the mountain making & worshipping The Golden Calf.
  - Moses is living High
  - Israel is living Low  
(blatantly breaking the first 2 of the 10)

## Exodus 32-34

- God is ready to end the relationship.
  - I will send my Angel, but I will not go...
- Moses intercedes for the people and God responds favorably.
  - Seems a righteous intercessor can rescue rebellious sinners. (remind you of anyone?)

## Exodus 33:11

11 So the LORD spoke to Moses face to face, as a man speaks to his friend. And he would return to the camp, but his servant Joshua, the son of Nun, a young man, did not depart from the tabernacle.

Remember: Moses has set up his tent on the outside of the camp – called The Tabernacle of Meeting.

## Exodus 33:13-15

13 "Now therefore, I pray, if I have found grace in Your sight, show me now Your way, that I may know You and that I may find grace in Your sight. And consider that this nation is Your people."

14 And He said, "My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest."

15 Then he said to Him, "If Your Presence does not go with us, do not bring us up from here."

## Exodus 33:16-17

16 "For how then will it be known that Your people and I have found grace in Your sight, except You go with us? So we shall be separate, Your people and I, from all the people who are upon the face of the earth."

17 So the LORD said to Moses, "I will also do this thing that you have spoken; for you have found grace in My sight, and I know you by name."

## Exodus 33:18-19

18 And he said, "Please, show me Your glory."

19 Then He said, "I will make all My goodness pass before you, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before you. I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion."

(then God gave Moses a mind-blowing experience)

god

# The Request: Please, show me Your glory

## What is the glory of God?

- **Glory** = weightiness, importance
  - idea = being worthy of **honor**
  - “hallowed be Your name”
- It's the **majesty**, **beauty**, **power**, riches, splendor, **awesomeness** of God.

# To See the Glory of God

- It's when God **chooses** to make His presence & power known.
  - The manifested **presence** of God
- These are the characteristics that make God **unique** from everything.  
(**Holy**, Holy, Holy)

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## Exodus 40:34-35

34 Then the cloud covered the tabernacle of meeting, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.

35 And Moses was not able to enter the tabernacle of meeting, because the cloud rested above it, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.

22 "And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one:

23 "I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me.

# My Goodness

- “Good” is a God word

God's goodness**






Glory of God = Goodness of God
