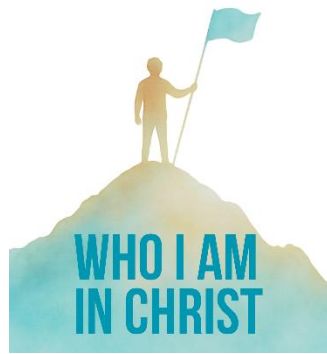

Helpful Tips

Here are some thoughts I hope will help you:

- **Biblical meditation** is different from other forms of meditation. Biblical meditation is about filling your mind with the Word of God. In order for us to be transformed into the image of Jesus, we must have our minds renewed. Our thoughts, viewpoints and ideologies about God, ourselves, life and people need to be reshaped by the truth of The Scriptures. Meditation is a big part of this. Hagah is one of the Hebrew words for meditate. Picture a lion standing over its prey, diving in, savoring every bite. This is Hagah. Hagah the Scriptures and live the abundant life Jesus promised. This resource is designed for you to “hagah” these covenant promises.
- **Ask the Holy Spirit to help you.** The Bible is one of the greatest gifts God has ever given. And it’s one of the most neglected. The Bible is the only book I know of where you can talk with the Author while you read it. Ask for insight and revelation as you read. See what parts of a verse or story really stand out to you. I call it reading in 3-D. Sometimes certain things just seem to jump off the page. Pay attention to the parts that grab your attention. The Holy Spirit may want you to spend some thinking time on this. And He may be leading you to do something about what you are reading. These are holy moments. Learn to ask, read, ask, read again and listen and do. The LORD wants you to hear His voice in His Word.
- **Memorize Scripture.** Find ways to plant the seed of God’s Word in your heart. Flashcards may help. Be creative. If you will be diligent to put God’s Word in your heart, the Spirit will bring it back to your remembrance when you need it. Psalm 119:11 says, “Your word I have hidden in my heart, that I might not sin against You!”
- **Study Scripture.** This goes beyond just reading. This is digging out the meaning of passages, thoughts, ideas and words to better understand the Text. Context is important. There are lots of helpful resources like software programs, commentaries and such to help with word studies and making sense of things.
- **Writing Scripture.** This can be a helpful practice for meditation. In a separate journal or notebook, write and re-write the Scriptures you are focusing on. In Bible days, the LORD required the kings of Israel to write out their own personal copy of the Scriptures and meditate on it. There is a connection that happens when you attentively write stuff down. Try it! You might find it helpful.

- **Speak the Word.** Another part of Biblical meditation is to speak the Word. It's a good practice to read the Word outloud to yourself, especially those parts that strike you. Practice speaking the Word to yourself, to your situation and to others. This is called declaring the Word of the LORD. When you do this in faith, the Word becomes your Sword, the Sword of the Spirit (Eph 6). Jesus in an epic battle with the adversary said, "It is written..." He declared the Word of the LORD and won the battle. This is a big part of our spiritual warfare.
- **Learn to Capture and Cast Down Wrong Thoughts.** Listen to this battle strategy from the Apostle Paul in 2 Corinthians 10:4-5.... *"For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ."* We are growing in the truth and learning what is required of us to be obedient to Christ. The more we learn the truth, the better we recognize the lies. When lies and wrong thoughts come, we cast them down and take them captive and bring these thoughts under the Lordship of Jesus. When temptation comes, be ready to respond in this way. Biblical meditation prepares you for this kind of spiritual warfare.
