Vendor Information



- Booth availability in the Fellowship Hall is limited and will be first come first serve (FCFS)..If you have a tent as part of your set up/display you will need to notify us as indoor space for tent use is limited.
- Flea/Yard sale Vendors Welcomed.
- All Vendor Fees are non-refundable,event is rain or shine.
- Space is limited. Fee is due at registration
- Forms must be completed in full. Information left incomplete or inaccurate will render the application invalid.
- All items for sale must be approved during the application process. See list of prohibited sale items.
- Vendors will be assigned their spaces and must remain in that assigned space unless permission to move is granted by the designated event staff.
- Booths with access to power are limited and will be granted on a FCFS basis. These spaces will not be held after acceptance past the 3 business days without payment.
- Indoor booth spaces are \$40 per space and measure 10'x10', Outdoor spaces are also 10x10 and are \$30 per space.
- Tables are provided at an additional cost (\$10 ea.) and are FCFS.
- All set up must be completed by 8:30am the morning of (Friday set up is available from 5p-7p the evening before) and Vendor Vehicles must be moved into the designated parking area. (Doors open for set up @ 7:00am, Vendor Parking in lower lot)
- Breakdown **MUST** be completed by 2:30pm. The church has to be locked *promptly at 2:30*.
- Vendors will receive an email detailing their acceptance to participate.
- Each vendor will be required to donate an item to be given away as a door prize to be valued at \$25. They need to have an affixed business card and ready at check-in
- The event is limited to 3 hours. Vendors are *expected* to be at the event for the duration unless you sell out of inventory early.

Prohibited Items



The following standards for items sold at this event are as follows:

- No items with graphic, offensive or explicit imagery
- No items with profanity written on them
- No items that promote or advertise drug or alcohol use
- No items containing CBD, Tobacco, or Alcohol
- No live animals to be sold
- Electronics/used baby products (car seats, dated baby products, etc)

All items offered must be approved by the designated event staff(ers).

Items to be sold must be listed below with accurate descriptions. Feel free to add additional pages if more space is needed.
