

What is Night to Shine Prom?

The Night to Shine Prom sponsored by the Tim Tebow Foundation is a magical evening for guests with special needs ages 14 and older. From the moment our guests arrive, each guest is truly treated like a king or queen. Each guest can participate in hair/make-up touch-up, shoe shine, professional photo, limo ride, walk the red carpet, dinner, dancing and games. The night ends with each guest being crowned a king or queen.

Who can attend?

The event is for guests 14 and older with physical or cognitive disabilities. Every guest **MUST** be registered **PRIOR** to the event. There is limited capacity, walk-in's will **NOT** be accommodated. This event is not suited for CP clients.

Are caregivers able to attend?

This is a night that caregivers can have the night out as well. After check-in, caregivers can leave their guest with the buddy volunteer and come back at 8:45pm OR there is a respite room available with light dinner and entertainment. Only 1-2 caregivers/guest are able to join in the respite room, please indicate at time of registration. At check-in you will be given a wristband to pick up your guest so the same person that checks-in guest, must pick up the guest.

What is a buddy?

Each guest will be matched with a buddy. This is a volunteer that will be the chaperone for each guest. It is very important that all questions are filled out at time of registration about what the physical or cognitive disability is to ensure the best volunteer is matched with our guest. If there is a guest with severe disability that the caregiver must stay with the guest but still wants a buddy, please indicate at registration a buddy is requested. Again, we have volunteers as young as 14 so this event is not suited for CP clients.

*****NEW THIS YEAR REGARDING BUDDIES AND GUESTS:***

In years past, we had our buddies call guests in advance. At times, there are unexpected changes and causes confusion, therefore this year guests **WILL NOT be called in advance**. Guests will meet their buddy at check-in and caregivers must give the buddy their contact information, and important health related details.

How long is the event and when should I arrive?

You will receive your arrival time a week prior to the event. VERY important we have the correct email and phone number listed on the registration form. The event ends at 9:00pm.

We have a group of friends that want to arrive at the same time?

At time of registration, indicate if you will be arriving with a friend or a group of friends, and every effort will be made to have the same arrival time, however no guarantees.

This event is coordinated by all volunteers, therefore a reply to emails may take 24-48 hours, Please, do not call Evergreen Christian Community or Evergreen Christian School with questions.
