Backpack Buddies Ministry is a
program through Forest Hills Church that seeks to fight
childhood hunger. We finished the school year serving
3,200 children

We work with our church, schools, organizations, and
volunteers to provide weekend and holiday meals to
support struggling students.

Each Friday, the students receive a grocery bag con-
taining 12-15 child-friendly items such as drinks,
proteins, fruits, snacks, and breakfast foods.

Ways to Get Involved:

Volunteer:

*A coordinator to prepare plastic bags, (i.e. Kroger
Publix, Walmart) to include collecting donated bags
from the church and stocking bags in bins to be filled
with food items for the children

*1 or 2 people to pack allergy bags for children with food
allergies.

*2 or 3 people to be at the Backpack House with
volunteering groups.

*Men or strong ladies to restock shelves 2 times per week

*Breakfast Bars, Poptarts, Fun Food such as individual
cookies, candy, chips, Cheez-Its
