We're just crowing with the news!! We need more volunteers to help at Respite!

If you are new to Forest Hills Church or are looking for a place to serve in God's Kingdom, Respite is the place for you. In Respite, we host our friends with mild to

moderate dementia while their care partners receive a break. Currently we are holding sessions on Tuesday and Thursdays from noon until 3:00pm, but with increased participation, we may be adding a session on Wednesdays. Volunteers arrive at 11:30am to participate in a planning huddle to be ready for the session. We stay until all friends have been picked up and our area is cleaned. This usually requires about 15 minutes after the conclusion of the session.



Volunteering is very easy. You get to share Christ's love with our families and have fun while doing so, but we also train you in the best ways to work with individuals with dementia. Three trainings are needed -- Ministry Safe (required refresher annually) is offered June 7 in the Ministry Center at 11:00am for first timers and at 12:00pm for refreshers. (Another date will be planned for a new participant that will not conflict with worship times). SRM I training will be held Monday, June 15 and SRM II will be held Monday, June 29. Both of these will begin at 6:00pm and include one hour training with pizza and ice cream in the Respite Room #115.

At Respite we have lots of fun and fellowship!!! Many of our volunteers say this is the best day of their week. You can volunteer each session, one day per week, or just a few days per month. Come join us for a day to see if participating in this ministry is for you.

We Love Local Missions 2026!

This June 10-14, youth from five churches will fill our church with excitement and a spirit of service as they participate in River of Life. ROL is at its heart, a youth experience, but it also showcases the community of Forest Hills, drawing on the gifts and talents of the entire



church. This enables our youth to serve, learn, and worship in memorable and life-changing ways.

Founded in 1991 at Lincolnton UMC, River of Life is a series of events held each summer aimed at enabling youth and adults to come together to express the love of Jesus Christ by ministering to the people through exterior home repairs and improvements. ROL participants will perform work ranging from painting to roofing to carpentry repairs. Teams of six to 15 teens and two or three adults will spend three days working in neighborhoods throughout Macon. Several of the homes have been selected through a continued partnership with Rebuilding Together that began with Forest Hills Church's first ROL in 2003.

Groups will arrive at FHC between 3-5 p.m. on July 10 and stay at the church for the remainder of the weekend. Volunteers will prepare breakfast each morning with work crews heading out early Thursday-Saturday. After work the crews head to designated shower sites (local schools and gyms) before returning to the church each afternoon, ready for a delicious meal prepared by FHC volunteers. Each night concludes with a high-energy worship service featuring the FHC praise band and guest speaker Jonathan Griggs, a former FHC youth, where he will expound on the theme of Illuminate, taken from Matthew 5:16: "In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven."

This year five churches from Georgia and Florida will participate: FHC, BridgePointe (Woodstock), Lake Shore (Jacksonville), Marth Bowman (Macon) and New Providence Baptist (Guyton).

So how can you jump into the River of Life?

- 1. Pray** - Begin praying now for the health and safety of our work crews, for good weather, for the homeowners we will serve, for our speaker and worship team, and, most importantly, for the Holy Spirit to move in the lives of all involved.
- 2. Donate** - The students and the adult chaperones actually PAY to come sweat in the summer heat and sleep on the church floor! However, donations from church members help supplement the costs associated with ROL (paint, carpentry supplies, meals, etc.). Simply designate your gift for River of Life.
- 3. VOLUNTEER!!!!** - ROL is only possible when the entire Forest Hills family comes together to be the body of Christ in action. In years past we have had close to a 1:1 ratio of volunteers to students; an amazing example to our students of what it looks like to serve God and others. Want to swing a hammer? Sign up to work on a crew. Love to cook? Help out preparing meals. Have the gift of hospitality? Greet students at registration or as they arrive at their shower sites.
