The weekend consists of four days within the prison compound, and during those days the participants will encounter self; encounter Christ; and encounter others. The ultimate vision of Kairos is to make disciples within the prison where they will minister to each other.

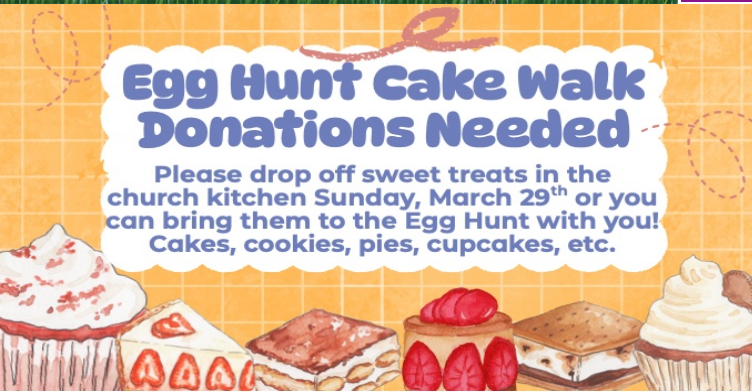
