
Forest Hills Church receives many donations given in memory or in honor of loved ones.

Kairos

Kairos International is a nondenominational, faith-based ministry to men, women and youth who are presently incarcerated. It is a ministry where the team members demonstrate the love of Christ through service and sharing. The weekend consists of four days within the prison compound, and during those days the participants will encounter self, encounter Christ, and encounter others. The ultimate vision of Kairos is to make disciples within the prison where they will minister to each other.

The transforming power of the Holy Spirit is so evident throughout the weekend. Each team member is blessed to be a witness to this transformation. We have witnessed anger turned to joy, apathy turned to praise and worship. Lives are changed!

The aftermath of each weekend is for the participants to become leaders inside the facility and to participate in Bible studies. In addition to the four day weekend, Pulaski State Women's Prison is again allowing participants and team members to return for a one day Kairos reunion of fellowship and worship.

How can you support this ministry? **Prayer** is foremost, prayers for each of the thirty-six participants chosen, the team members, and the prison staff. **Monetary support**, the cost of each weekend is approximately \$5,000. Donations can be made via the Church Center web site. Meal tickets can be purchased for \$5. each, and we feed each participant and team member nine meals. **Prayer chains** and **placemats** for meal time are always a highlight for the weekend. If you feel led by the Holy Spirit to become a Kairos team member, please seek out Judy Fountain or Lee Triesenberg for the women's Kairos, Tom Adkisson or Conn Fountain for men's Kairos. It is an awesome opportunity and experience to serve this population!

Chicken Cobbler Ingredients

- 1 box garlic & herb biscuit mix (or Red Lobster Cheddar Bay mix)
- 1 large can chicken
- 1 large can peas & carrots (or 2 small cans)
- 1 can diced potatoes
- 1 can evaporated milk
- 1 can cream of chicken soup

These ingredients can be purchased at the grocery store or most dollar stores. Return the filled bags to the church office or to any Missions Committee member wearing a chef's hat.

All bags need to be returned by Sunday, March 22.

Even as we move forward to our next mission project, we will continue to support Lighthouse with our 50 meals on the 5th Sunday. You may pick up your bag at the church which will contain instructions on what needs to go in the bag and return it to the church where it will be picked up and delivered to Lighthouse. The first 5th Sunday will be March 29th, so please have your bags at the church by March 22nd.
