MINISTRONE SOUP



Servings: 6
Prep Time: 10 minutes
Cook Time: 20 minutes

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 1/2 cups small pasta (such as shells or macaroni)
- 24 ounce pasta sauce
- 1 can kidney beans (rinsed and drained)
- 1 can carrots (drained)
- 1 can green beans (drained)
- 1 can diced tomatoes (undrained)
- 1 to 2 bouillon cubes



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. In a large pot combine pasta sauce, diced tomatoes, green beans, kidney beans, carrots, and bouillon cube(s).
2. Add 3 to 4 cups of water depending on how thick you like your soup.
3. In a large pot combine pasta sauce, diced tomatoes, green beans, kidney beans, carrots, and bouillon cube(s).
4. Season to taste with salt and pepper (can add additional Italian seasonings if desired)
5. Bring to a boil, then add pasta.
6. Cover and simmer for 12 to 15 minutes, stirring occasionally or until pasta is tender.
