Our primary emphasis for December and January is the ministry located at Heritage Southside. Mr. Ray Rover had a vision to do something with the gym next to the Southside UMC. In 2010, Ray purchased 2 basketballs, and walked Capitol Ave. seeking kids who wanted to play basketball. Today the ministry aims to meet the needs of the community located at the intersection of Houston Ave. & Rocky Creek Rd. This ministry is presently part of the Heritage Southside Church, which is an arm of Heritage Meth. Church located on Forsyth Rd. The earliest ministry was "Scrambled Eggs for Jesus". A group gathers each Sunday morning and serves breakfast to 100-120 people from the neighborhood.

They currently have a tutoring program that consists of a meal, a time for learning, followed by a time of sharing the gospel. They also have a computer lab, a small library, a clothing closet and a small grocery pantry. There are many opportunities for volunteering and serving in this ministry - assisting with tutoring, cooking breakfast or sorting through the donated clothes. Being a presence is also so important. Financial donations are also a means of supporting the mission.
