Hello from Haiti!

We've fostered over 30 children so far, but Julia's story is by far the most depressing.

Two streets over from where we live, a newborn baby girl was thrown down the outhouse hole. The "toilet" basically consisted of a small shack with a hole in the ground for community use. Of course, she got sick as the appalling pictures in our mind can only slightly imagine the torture she was put through. She was covered in bacteria, lying in a dark, wet, feces-filled hole. She was thrown away. Unwanted. Left to die.

But God...

Someone heard her one-day-old screams and jumped in, risking his own life to save hers. She was hospitalized for a month where she was treated with medication but was also neglected. Without a mother to care for her, she lay in a bed all day and night. She was rarely fed, never bathed, and she was not given the nurturing love and compassion that she deserved. The nurses were too busy with everyone else and when you're hospitalized in Haiti, you must provide everything yourself. If you're an infant, with no caregiver, there's no one to buy you formula or diapers and so you end up neglected. Forgotten about. Wasting away.

But God...

Haiti's Department of Children Services was contacted. We were asked to take her in until they find a long-term foster family. She needed care. She deserved love. So, she received a family.

Miss Julia.

My precious little six pound miracle baby saved by the grace of God from the devil's hands.

Her story starts now.

Julia is loved, wanted, and cared for. She has a purpose on this earth and through the Lord's guidance, she will grow up knowing how adored she is. How special she is. How important she is on this earth. She is a miracle.

Our God is a redeeming God. Our God is a miracle worker. Our God can use any tragedy, trauma, or depression, and refine it into a beautiful masterpiece filled with everlasting blessings.
