As we enter our season of prayer and fasting, we want to invite you to take this time to slow down and focus on God.

Fasting is simply choosing to set something aside — often food, but it can be anything that tends to take our attention — so we can make more room for God. When we pair fasting with prayer, it helps us listen more closely, reflect more honestly, and see God's work in our lives with fresh eyes.

Our theme this year is FaithFULL, inspired by Hebrews 10:23: “Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful.”

As we move through these weeks together, may we be reminded that God keeps His promises and meets us whenever we choose to seek Him.

Your FaithFULL Prayer and Fasting Journey

This 14-day guide takes you through a journey of faith:

- **Days 1-5:** Building your personal faith and deepening your relationship with God (Experiencing God)
- **Days 6-10:** Living faithfully in community and encouraging others (Creating Community)
- **Days 11-14:** Stepping out in faith to reach those who don't yet know Jesus (Reaching Beyond)



DAYS 1-5: EXPERIENCING GOD

DAY 1 | FEBRUARY 8

FAITH TO EXPERIENCE GOD'S PRESENCE



Ephesians 3:12 (NLT) "Because of Christ and our faith in him, we can now come boldly and confidently into God's presence."



Pray for a deeper sense of His presence in your everyday life. Express your gratitude for Jesus' sacrifice that makes this possible. Are you coming boldly and confidently into his presence, what does this mean for you?



DAY 2 | FEBRUARY 9

TRUSTING IN GOD'S FAITHFULNESS



Lamentations 3:22-23 (NLT) "The faithful love of the LORD never ends! His mercies never cease. Great is his faithfulness; his mercies begin afresh each morning."



Thank God for His faithfulness in your own life. Think about how you might experience his mercies new every morning and ask Him to reveal more about His faithful character.





DAY 3 | FEBRUARY 10

FAITH THAT SEES THE UNSEEN



2 Corinthians 5:7 (AMP) For we walk by faith, not by sight [living our lives in a manner consistent with our confident belief in God's promises]



Pray for the faith to trust God when you can't see the full picture. Ask Him to help you walk by faith in areas where you're tempted to rely only on what you can see or understand.



DAY 4 | FEBRUARY 11

FAITH THROUGH HIS WORD



Romans 10:17 (NLT) "So faith comes from hearing, that is, hearing the Good News about Christ."



Ask God to give you a real hunger for His Word. Pray for help staying consistent with reading Scripture, and for your faith to grow as He speaks to you through his word.





DAY 5 | FEBRUARY 12

FAITH THAT OVERCOMES



1 John 5:4 (AMP) For everyone born of God is victorious and overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has conquered and overcome the world—our [continuing, persistent] faith [in Jesus the Son of God].



Thank God that your faith in Him gives you victory. Pray for faith to overcome specific challenges or spiritual battles you're facing, trusting that He has already won the victory.



DAYS 6-10: CREATING COMMUNITY

DAY 6 | FEBRUARY 13

FAITH EXPRESSED IN LOVE



Galatians 5:6 (AMP) For [if we are] in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision means anything, but only faith activated and expressed and working through love.



Ask God to help your faith show up as love in your relationships. Pray for specific people in your life and ask Him to show you practical ways to love them well.





DAY 7 | FEBRUARY 14

FAITH IN UNITY



Ephesians 4:2 - 5 (NIV) Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called: one Lord, one faith, one baptism.



Pray for unity at Clovie. Ask God if there is anything about your faith journey that may lead to disunity and pray that he would grant you wisdom to know what steps to take to walk in his peace.



DAY 8 | FEBRUARY 15

FAITHFUL SERVICE



Colossians 3:23-24 (NLT) "Work willingly at whatever you do, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people. Remember that the Lord will give you an inheritance as your reward, and that the Master you are serving is Christ."



Ask God to help you stay faithful as you serve Him and others. Pray about practical ways you can use your gifts and resources to build up the people around you.





DAY 9 | FEBRUARY 16

FAITH THAT ENCOURAGES



Ephesians 4:29 (NIV) Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.



Ask God to help your words bring encouragement to people around you. Pray for Him to gently show you where you might not be building others up, and for the wisdom you need to honour Him in how you speak.



DAY 10 | FEBRUARY 17

FAITH AND FELLOWSHIP



Acts 2:42 (NLT) "All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals (including the Lord's Supper), and to prayer."



Thank God for the gift of community and fellowship. Pray for deeper connections with other believers, and for help staying committed to gathering together for teaching, fellowship, and prayer.





DAYS 11-14: REACHING BEYOND

DAY 11 | FEBRUARY 18

FAITH TO SHARE THE GOSPEL



Romans 1:16 (NLT) "For I am not ashamed of this Good News about Christ. It is the power of God at work, saving everyone who believes—the Jew first and also the Gentile."



Ask God for boldness and faith to share Jesus with others. Pray for specific people who need to hear about Jesus and for courage to speak about your faith. Ask for divine appointments with these people and that He would speak through you.



DAY 12 | FEBRUARY 19

FAITH IN ACTION



James 2:14-17 NIV What good is it, my brothers and sisters, if someone claims to have faith but has no deeds? Can such faith save them? Suppose a brother or a sister is without clothes and daily food. If one of you says to them, "Go in peace; keep warm and well fed," but does nothing about their physical needs, what good is it? In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead.



Pray that your faith would be active and visible through the things you do. Ask God to show you practical ways to live out your faith by serving and helping people beyond your immediate circle.





DAY 13 | FEBRUARY 20

FAITH FOR THE HARVEST



Matthew 9:37-38 (NLT) "He said to his disciples, 'The harvest is great, but the workers are few. So pray to the Lord who is in charge of the harvest; ask him to send more workers into his fields.'"



Pray for faith to see the spiritual harvest all around you. Ask God to send more workers into the harvest field and pray about how you might be one of those workers reaching people with the Good News.



DAY 14 | FEBRUARY 21

FAITH THAT LOOKS TO JESUS



Hebrews 12:2 (NLT) "We do this by keeping our eyes on Jesus, the champion who initiates and perfects our faith. Because of the joy awaiting him, he endured the cross, disregarding its shame. Now he is seated in the place of honour beside God's throne."



Thank Jesus for being the author and the editor of your faith. Ask Him to help you keep your eyes locked on Him as you experience God, create community, and reach beyond. Pray for endurance and joy as you live out your faith in every area of life.



Throughout these 14 days, take time to listen to what God is saying to you about being faithFULL at Clovie.

- What is He asking you to believe Him for?
- How is He calling you to step out in faith in this community?
- Is there something specific He's saying to us as a community about being faithFULL?

Listen, and then respond with courage.
