#### Part 1 - INTRODUCTION

#### 1. Introduction/Background/Rationale

Following the 27 November 2023 Members' Meeting, Pathway Community Centre submitted amendments to the constitution with a copy of the updated constitution to Consumer and Business Services, as required within one month after approval of amendments.

Consumer and Business Services completed a review of the constitution and outlined some updates they require as per legislation.

#### 2. Rationale and Process

It was not imperative that we vote on these amendments as they were requested by law, however as the constitution requires Members to vote on changes, Church Council decided to present the updates to our Members.

Clause 18 of the constitution requires Members be given at least sixty (60) days' notice prior to a Meeting of the Member called to vote on any proposed changes to the constitution and that any changes made shall be passed by a majority of not less than 75% of Church Member votes cast at the Meeting of the Member.





#### Part 2 – AMENDMENTS

## 1. Section 19 – Manner of Winding Up

Current	Recommended Change
<ol> <li>Pathway may be wound up pursuant to a resolution passed by a majority of not less than 75% of church member votes cast at a Meeting of the Member especially convened for the purpose. It shall then be wound up in the manner provided for in the Act.</li> </ol>	At least 21 days' notice will be provided for a Special Resolution for winding up. Pathway may be wound up pursuant to a Special Resolution passed by a majority of not less than 75% of Church Member votes cast at a Meeting of the Member especially convened for the purpose. It shall then be wound up in the manner provided for in the Act.

Rationale: Consumer and Business Services requested an update to include providing 21 days' notice prior to a Special Resolution for winding up.
