Sermon Recap

- Psalm 122 shows pilgrims arriving in Jerusalem with joy to worship God together.
- In Christ, the church is the fulfillment of what Jerusalem foreshadowed—a gathering of God's people in His presence.
- We're called to gather with joyful anticipation, right priorities, and covenant love.

- 4. **Right Priorities** What are some wrong reasons people attend church today, and how might those distract from true worship?
- 5. **Obedience & Submission** Why do you think submission to God's authority is so counter-cultural today?

6. **Covenant Love** – What's one tangible way we can pray for and pursue the good of our church family this week?
