



Growth Group Opener:

Has there ever been a time when God's greatness and majesty suddenly felt overwhelming or very real to you? What was that experience like?

Week 1: Read Revelation 1: 1-18

What characteristic stands out to you from the description of Jesus in v.13-16?
What is the significance of that characteristic?

How does this description of Jesus spark your imagination?

Read: John 13:21-25

What do we see in the relationship between John, called the disciple whom Jesus loved, and Jesus? What is noteworthy about their interaction here?

Going back to Revelation, given their relationship, why do you think John's response was to fall at Jesus' feet as though dead?



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How does John's response contrast with what Jesus speaks to him?

How should the appearance and words of the risen Jesus in this passage shape our interactions with Him? How should it shape the way we hold Him in our thoughts? How should it shape our actions?

We see the 7 churches described as 7 lamp stands in this passage. In what ways should the church be like a lamp stand?

What do we learn about God in this passage?

Is there anything you feel the Holy Spirit nudging you to look at more closely?
