Growth Group Opener:

What is an experience you have had where you gradually became complacent without realizing it? What did you do about it?

Week 8: Revelation 3:14-22

What might it look like if a church is hot, as in zealous and on fire for God?

In contrast, how might the church at Laodicea have presented, in their lukewarm state?

How did Jesus describe himself in this letter?

How does this connect with what was going on in this church?

What contrast does Jesus draw between the Laodicean church's priorities of wealth and acquisition, and their true condition before God?

Has there been anything in your life that you mistakenly prioritized that left you looking poor, blind, and pitiful before God?

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What is the remedy for this lukewarm condition in v18?
What is the significance of these items?

What kind of relationship is assumed in v20? (See also John 10:27.)

Read Isaiah 55

What do these passages reveal about God's true heart and desire for His people?
What is the invitation he is extending?

Is there anything you feel the Holy Spirit nudging you to look at more closely?

On your own time:

**Consider the temperature of your current relationship with God.
What can you do to turn up the heat?**
