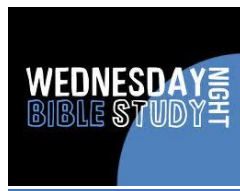

We are still collecting microwavable macaroni & cheese. You can bring them to the church office or place in the box in Ministry Center.

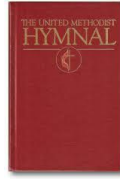
