H.E.A.R JOURNAL

The HEAR Journal helps us grow as we read and learn from the Word that became flesh. Before you begin reading, pray that God would open your eyes to the truth of His Word, and lead you in understanding to obedience.

H - Highlight

This exercise will remind you to read with purpose. Highlight each verse that speaks to you by copying it under the letter H.

E - Explain

By asking some simple questions, with the help of God's Spirit, you can understand the meaning of the passage.

- Why was this text written?
- To whom was it originally written?
- How does this text fit with the verse before and after?
- What does the Holy Spirit intend to communicate?

A - Apply

Application is the heart of the process. A series of questions will help in making the text personal.

- What does this text teach me about God?
- What would the application of this passage look like in my life?

R - Repspond

Your response to the passage may take on many forms. The importance is to communicate personally and intimately what you have read with the Father.

H.E.A.R JOURNAL EXAMPLE

Reading: Philippians 4

H - Highlight

Philippians 4:13, "I can do all things through Him who strengthens me." (ESV)

E - Explain

Paul was telling the church of Philippi that he had discovered the secret of contentment. No matter the situation in Paul's life, he realized that Christ was all he needed, and Christ was the One who strengthened him to persevere through difficult times.

A - Apply

In my life I will experience many ups and downs. My contentment isn't found in circumstances. Rather, it's based on my relationship with Jesus Christ. Only Jesus gives me the strength I need to be content in every circumstance of life.

R - Repspond

Lord Jesus, please help me as I strive to be content in You. Through Your strength I can make it through any situation I must face.

LIFE GROUPS Explained

What is a Life Group?

A Life Group is small group of individuals committed to growing together through the Word of God.

BIG PROBLEMS, ONE SIMPLE SOLUTION

Two of the biggest barriers to growth in the church are a lack of Biblical engagement and a lack of authentic accountability. Without these two things – personal Bible reading and accountable relationships – most of us will eventually stall in our spiritual growth. The goal of Life Groups is to help solve this problem! The greatest benefit of a Life Group is the plan and accountability it provides to help get people into the Word and keep them in the Word until the Word gets into them.

Our Life Groups should desire to have a simple plan and a repeatable process that anyone can follow and facilitate to others in personal growth and multiplying more Life Groups!

We believe that the Word of God and the Spirit of God are more than enough to do the work of God through the people of God! And like Jesus modeled, we believe discipleship is best done in community.

LIFE GROUP Model

1. Begin With Prayer
2. Celebrate Victories
3. Read Highlighted Scripture
4. Explain The Scripture In Context
5. Seek Ways To Apply The Scripture Together
6. Pray Through The Scripture
7. Establish Prayer And Accountability Partners For The Next Week
8. Look For Ways To Serve Together As A Life Group
