## 2 KINGS 4:1-44

OTHER TEXT(S): 1 JOHN 3:1

- Icebreaker question: Who has been the most generous person in your life? Why is it remember those who show up in our lives when we need them most?
- [2 Kings 4:1-7] What can we learn from Elisha and the Widow's Oil? How does God's generosity rise up when we're desperate?
- [2 Kings 4:8-37] What can we learn from Elisha and Shunammite woman and her son? How does God's generosity rise up when we face death?
- [2 Kings 4:38-44] What can we learn from Elisha purifying the deadly stew? How does God's generosity rise up when we things to destroy ourselves?

Final thought: God's generosity delivers more than we can imagine!

- Reflection: Write out how God has been generous to you this day/week/month/year. How do you respond to His generosity? Do people experience God's love and abundance through your generosity to those around you? Why or why not?
- Application: How will you align your life with God's generous heart to meet the needs of desperate and dying people in need of God's love?
