### Discussion Questions

1. What does the greek word "koinonia" (κοινωνία) mean and why is it important?
2. How is the church different than any other community? (Or how should the church be different than any other community?)
3. Why is the saying, "I love God, but I hate the church" an unhealthy and even dangerous sentiment to hold on to despite understandable reasons why people may feel this way?
4. "Communism says what's yours is mine, Capitalism says what's mine is mine, Christianity says what's mine is actually God's and yours!" — Does your life reflect a life radical generosity?
5. What can you learn from Acts 2:46-47?
6. As the Holy Spirit empowers you, how can you be on mission with God this week?

### Walk It Out Challenge

- Live Out Koinonia: intentionally share life with another believer this week—grab coffee, cook a meal, or check in with someone you've been distant from.
- Practice Radical Generosity. Give something this week that costs you—time, money, or resources. Maybe pay for someone's meal, give anonymously, or donate something valuable.
