5. What are the loaves and fish God has given you?
6. Are there any people in your life who inspire you to be more like the little boy who offered up his food?
7. [Reflection] Take some time to share some testimonies of God's provision/generosity towards you or someone in your life.

SACRAMENTO CAMPUS DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Share a time when you have moved (positionally in your career, geographically, or spiritually). Where did you start and where did you end up? Was it a good move or a bad one? Explain.

3. Do you value comfort too much to be committed? Why would this be an issue for a follower of Jesus?
4. [Ruth 2:5-7] Why shouldn't you try to keep someone who wants to go from leaving?
5. [Ruth 3:1-6] What can you learn from Naomi and Ruth from this passage?
6. Why is it important to not stop doing what you have to do (and develop good, healthy habits) even if it's work that you don't want to do?
7. What are the 5 Do's Pastor Bob shared from the book of Ruth? Which of those can you apply in your life this week?
