### What Is the Gospel?

The Gospel is good news — The good news that the Kingdom of God is here.

### The Kingdom Has Come

Mark 1:14-15

“The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe the good news!”

Jesus came proclaiming (kēryssō — to herald, to announce boldly) that what God’s people had long awaited was finally here.

- The Old Testament declares the Kingdom is coming
- The New Testament tells us the King has come.

### The \_\_\_\_\_ of the Kingdom

Mark 1:17

“Follow me... and I will make you fish for people.”

The call is not merely to admire Jesus, it is to follow Him.

Belief and obedience are connected.

Faith walks. Faith submits. Faith follows.

### The \_\_\_\_\_ of the Kingdom

When the Kingdom arrived, it came with:

### Authority & Power

- Authority in teaching | Over unclean spirits | Over illness (Mark 1:30-31)

### Compassion

Compassion is empathy in action.

Jesus:

- Preached the Good News | Healed the sick

**Faith in Action:** The Kingdom is here and the Lord says Follow Me.


