Mark 13:1-13

- Near: The destruction of Jerusalem (A.D. 70)
- Far: Christ's future return

Key Thought:

God's promises often have both an immediate and an ultimate fulfillment.

Mark 13:7

"Don't be alarmed..."

Jesus says we should expect:

- Wars
- Natural disasters
- Persecution
- Family conflict

These are reminders that this world is temporary—not reasons to panic.

God Calls Us to _____

Mark 13:13

"The one who endures to the end will be saved."

Waiting isn't passive.

Faith keeps moving while it waits.

"Be on guard! Be alert!"

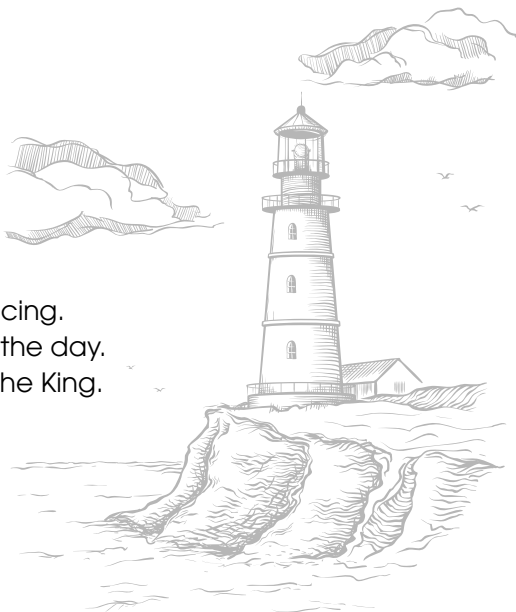
