Week 3: From Prison to Palace

Main Scripture Passage:

 Genesis 40-41

Key Verse:

 Genesis 41:38-40

Main Idea:

 God's timing is perfect, even when we wait.

Key Points from the Sermon:

1. **Joseph Interprets Dreams in Prison (Genesis 40:1-23)** – Serving even in suffering.
2. **Pharaoh's Dream and Joseph's Promotion (Genesis 41:1-40)** – God exalts the humble.
3. **Joseph's New Purpose (Genesis 41:41-57)** – Preparation leads to provision.

Reflection Question: What stood out to you the most from this week's sermon?

Discussion Questions:

1. Begin by asking the group, “How is it with your soul this week?”
 2. Why do you think God allowed Joseph to remain in prison for so long?
 3. How do you handle seasons of waiting in your life?
 4. How did Joseph's hardships prepare him for leadership? How has God used difficult times to prepare you for something greater?
 5. What are some ways we can remain faithful and trust God's timing?
