DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Introductory

1. What stood out to you from this week's devotions?

2. Share a time when someone met a real need for you. How did that impact you?
3. In your normal weekly routine, where do you naturally notice or miss people's needs? When you notice, what do you tend to do about those needs?

Scripture

4. Read Matthew 25:31-46. Good works are not the *root* of salvation, they are the *fruit*. Why is it important to keep that distinction clear?
5. Why do you think Jesus emphasizes caring for those in need as evidence of genuine faith (*also devotional question 1 this week*)?
6. How does this passage challenge a purely internal or private view of faith?

Application

7. It was said this weekend "evidence determines the verdict." In other words, true salvation produces visible fruit. What does the current evidence of your life suggest? Where might the Spirit be prompting repentance or growth?
8. In which environments or relationships do you tend to avoid engagement with the needs around you? Why?
9. Consider and share about one person or situation that feels like an interruption. How can you plan to respond differently in light of seeing it as an opportunity to serve Jesus?
10. Where might God be calling you to deviate from your routine? What margin (time, emotional energy, resources) might you need to build into your life to engage faithfully?
