PURPOSE STATEMENT: To help people live Jesus-centered lives by assisting with music creation and team development and ensuring consistent quality of weekend service execution and volunteer team culture at the local campus level.

EMPLOYMENT STATUS & HOURLY REQUIREMENTS: Full-time, 40+ hours, Sunday-Thursday

Description:

- Recruit volunteers for music teams
- Work with central staff for auditioning, onboarding, and training
- Develop and coach volunteers alongside the central staff
- Prepare and execute all music elements on Sundays at a specific campus
- Work alongside campus production coordinator for specific campus-needs
- Lead from the stage at least 3 times a month
- Shepherd and lead music volunteers in cooperation with central staff
- Keep spaces clean and instruments/systems maintained
- Represent staff team in campus staff meetings and in collaboration with campus-specific events (i.e. Good Friday Service, high school worship night, etc.)
- Assist with overall departmental needs and special projects
- Other duties as assigned
